

Volunteer activities for forest preservation at “JX Nakajo Forest” in Tainai City, Niigata Pref.

～Planting approx. 2,000 Japanese black pine seedlings～

JX Nippon Oil & Gas Exploration Corporation (President, Shigeo Hirai) is pleased to announce that we have performed volunteer work for the forest preservation at “JX Nakajo Forest” in the neighborhood of our Nakajo Field Office (located in Tainai City, Niigata; General Manager Yutaka Yamada) as part of our environmental contribution activities on November 9 and 10.

In the area where the Nakajo Oil and Gas Field is located, the forest devastation has recently progressed because of the damage by pine weevils. To cope with the situation, since 1998 Nakajo Field Office has promoted the project of forest preservation in its precincts and surrounding areas, and has achieved good results in the forest regeneration, such as by growing seedlings from the parent Japanese black pine trees.

Further, we have developed a hands-on program of forest preservation volunteer activities with participation of directors and employees of JX Group companies and their family since 2004. The occasion this time marks the tenth event with five (5) foreign employees joining for the first time from Vietnam and Malaysia. Total of 55 volunteers planted approximately 2,000 young Japanese black pine trees at “JX Nakajo Forest” during these two (2) days.

We commit to continue the promotion of the forest preservation activities in the area surrounding Nakajo Field Office as the activity reflects two of the action guidelines in the JX Group Values, “Harmony with the Environment” and “Relationship with Society”.

Our company has executed the “Agreement on the JX Nakajo Forestation Activities” with the Tainai City and Nakamurahama District in October 2011, and has worked on the activities for forestation in partnership with them. This program is granted support from Niigata Prefecture under the “Niigata Forestation Support Program” which the Prefecture promotes.
